where R@T onto B4402, then 1st L sp
CEFNDWYSARN 14.0
Climb & descend to school on L **INFO** 16.0
L@X onto A494 sp 16.2
R sp LLANFOR 19.7
Wind through village and climb past electric sub
station to L@fork (no through road sign to R) onto
gated road, climb & descend to R@T

Thro farm & R@T onto B4501 24.8
2nd L sp CWMPANNANER 27.5
Climb & descend to imm L by chapel **INFO**
32.2
Climb & follow road to R & thro gate 32.7
R@T no sp 34.0
1st L no sp & climb through farm 34.5
Descend to X & SO (ignore “no through road” sign)
37.4
L@T no sp 38.0
Continue to **CONTROL** in PENTREFOELAS @
café/shop on R 40.0
Open 10:36 Close 12:12

Pentrefoelas to Llyn Brenig 45km

Cross A5 to head northwest on B5113 (PH on L) and
continue on thro NEBO 46.4
Climb to R@ sharp LH bend sp GWYTHERIN
49.0
*(Note--keep eyes peeled for stone shell of
barn, just a few bricks high, in field on R
just before turn. Huge wind farm soon on L
as you follow this road after R turn).*
Eventually descend steeply to GWYTHERIN 55km
R after PH sp LLANSANAN B5384 55.2
R@T sp LLANSANAN 60.8
Descend & R@T on to A544 62.0
R in LLANSANAN sp LLYN ALED opp war
memorial **INFO** 62.5
Climb to LLYN ALED & **INFO** on R at tower on 2nd
dam 74.5
L@T A543 no sp and climb past Sportsman's Arms
(now closed) on L (464m) 72.5
R sp CERRIGYDRUIDION; LLYN BRENNIG
B4501 76.5

L@sign “VISITOR CENTRE” and follow to
CONTROL @ CAFÉ 85.0
Open 12:24 Close 15:48

Llyn Brenig to Corwen 22k

Either retrace steps out of visitor centre & L onto
B5401 or follow exit signs back onto B5401 (adds
1.5k)
Descend, climb a bit then descend (all downhill
now) to CERRIGYDRUIDION 90.5
R@T & imm L by church 90.5
Pass Londis shop to L@T 91.0
Follow [A5]**, gradually descending to **CORWEN**.
Control 107
Open 13:17 Close 17:34

**Alternative quiet and scenic finish to avoid busy
final section of A5 after Bala traffic merges: At TL
approx 15k from **Cerrigydrudion** turn acute back
right up A494 towards Bala (garage bay on L can
assist safe crossing) and imm. L. L@T 1k to
R&immL@X 2k and follow to L in front of Blue
Lion in **Cynwyd**. 3k
R@T (A5) 6k into **Corwen** 7k. Adds 3k.

Notes:

Public car parks at start near Craft Centre.
Register from 08:05 with free cuppa

**Please do not arrive at the cafe before 08:05 as we
have a number of riders to release on the 200k and
do not have room for you before this time.**

The route traverses remote hill areas so ensure that
you have sufficient, tubes, spares and expertise to
repair bike if necessary. “Bonk rations” should be
carried in case of delays. Low gears are an asset.
Take care on steep ascents and descents which can
be twisty, greasy and have free roaming livestock
and their offerings..
You may wish to fit mudguards as Welsh farm roads
can be wet & muddy.
